Why do we do what we do?

WHY PRAY?

1. It is the Right Thing to do Don't see any reward
Do not feel any real passion in it

But we know it is the right thing! Before we enter into salvation we know this!
I am in God's army now

*1 Timothy 2:8 Therefore I want the **men (foot soldiers)** in every place to pray, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and dissension. NASB95*

It makes God happy.
Then we see God begin to answer some of our prayers 3, 4, 5, etc...
And we understand there is a benefit to prayer!

2. For the reward Mow grass get the car on Friday/Saturday night

Needs met **Matthew 7:9-11** *9*“Or what man is there among you who, when his son asks for a loaf, will give him a stone? *10*“Or if he asks for a fish, he will not give him a snake, will he? *11*“If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him! *NASB95*

Mysteries revealed **Jeremiah 33:3** *3*‘Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which you do not know.’ *NASB95*

Get relief from guilt **1 John 1:9** *9*If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

End to worry **Philippians 4:6-7** *6*Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. *7*And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. *NASB95*

3. **Called to it** Everyone not just the “Prayer Professionals”
Intercessors, Watchmen, Prayer Warriors, Armor Bearers,

Prayer, deep intimate prayer, is the privilege / birthright of every born-again believer.

Song of Solomon 7:10-12 *10*“I am my beloved’s, And his desire is for me. *11*“Come, my beloved, let us go out into the country, Let us spend the night in the villages. *12*“Let us rise early and go to the vineyards; Let us see whether the vine has budded And its blossoms have opened, And whether the pomegranates have bloomed. There I will give you my love. **NASB95**

God doesn’t need anything, but He needs me.
I mow my dad’s grass now not because of the reward But because I love Him.
My love has matured.

PRAYER CENTERPIECE OF THE CHURCH

God said in the last days, He was going to restore David’s Tabernacle

Acts 15:15-18 *15*“With this the words of the Prophets agree, just as it is written, *16*‘After these things I will return, And **I will rebuild the tabernacle of David** which has fallen, And I will rebuild its ruins, And I will restore it, *17*So that the rest of mankind may seek the Lord, And all the Gentiles who are called by My name,’ *18*Says the Lord, who makes these things known from long ago. **NASB95**

Is 56:7, Matt 21:13, Mark 11:17, Luke 19:46 ... all same the same thing

Isaiah 56:7 Even those I will bring to My holy mountain And **make them joyful** in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; For My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples.” **NASB95**

END TIME PRAYER MOVEMENT ... Is About Enjoyable Prayer

Zechariah 8:18-21 *18*Then the word of the Lord of hosts came to me, saying, *19*“Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘The fast of the fourth, the fast of the fifth, the fast of the seventh and the fast of the tenth months **will become joy, gladness, and cheerful** feasts for the house of Judah; so love truth and peace.’ *20*“Thus says the Lord of hosts, ‘It will yet be that peoples will come, even the inhabitants of many cities. *21*‘The inhabitants of one will go to another, saying, “Let us go at once to entreat the favor of the Lord, and to seek the Lord of hosts; I will also go.” **NASB95**

- Place of Spiritual Warfare

- Place of Prayer for the Nations
- Place Where Bondage and Legalism are Removed / Healing for the Sick
- Place Where people receive an anointing which is carried with them to their homes, offices and schools.
